First stop is the Argyle Township Court House & Gaol. It is Canada's oldest standing courthouse, built in the village of Tusket, in 1805. It operated as a working courthouse and jail from 1805 until 1944.

While in Tusket we will visit the Hanging Oak Antiques store to have a glance at the hidden treasures.

**Lunch will be pre-planned at the Hatfield House one of the oldest properties in Tusket, dating back to 1793.*

We will continue to Yarmouth where we will visit the Cape Forchu Lightstation for a group photo! Our day isn't over yet!

We're taking the Evangeline Trail scenic route to a few hot spots for the antique enthusiast.
